Morning Drop-Off (AM) Procedures

Morning drop-off begins at 7:30 AM and may not be dropped off prior to 7:30 AM.

If your child is having breakfast at school, please drop them off no later than 7:45 AM.

Parents will enter the district office loop and drop-off students at the district office door (Exit 1).

Staff will be available to greet students entering the building at 7:30 AM.

For safety purposes, all cars in the loop are to remain in their order of arrival/entry.

Afternoon Pick-Up (PM) Procedures

Afternoon pick-up is 2:40-2:55 daily (gate will be raised once the last bus leaves the Tuscarora campus).

Vehicles will enter the Bus Loop in front of Tuscarora Elementary School. This is ONE LANE ONLY.

Families will remain in their cars and identity will be confirmed by staff at vehicle. Once identity has been confirmed, student will be released from the supervision location to families by the afternoon dismissal team. Students will exit the building through the Exit 6 (between Library and Cafeteria).

For safety purposes, all cars in the loop are to remain in their order of arrival/entry.

WHEN TO KEEP A CHILD HOME WITH ILLNESS

It can be hard to know when to send children to school if they tell you that they do not feel well. Usually, the best place for them is in school, but there are some times when keeping them home to rest or call for an appointment with your health care provider is recommended.

Please keep your child home and/or contact your child's doctor for:

- Fever greater than 100.4° (taken by mouth)
- Vomiting and/or diarrhea within the last 24 hours
- Severe sore throat along with fever and feeling ill for more than 48 hours, or after exposure to Strep throat infection
- Honey-crusted sores around the nose or mouth or rash on other body parts
- Large amounts of mucous (liquid) from their nose, with face pain or headache
- Severe ear pain or fluid coming from the ear
- Severe headache, especially with fever

If your child has a fever, it is not a good idea to give them medicine like Tylenol or Advil and send them to school because as soon as the medicine wears off, the fever may return and you will be called to come and pick up your child.

Please keep children home for 24 hours after the fever ends or they have completed 24 hours of medication if prescribed by your health care provider.

If you find your child is frequently asking to stay home from school, if they are falling behind or appear anxious about school, or if there does not appear to be any physical symptoms, contact your school nurse and your health care provider to discuss your concerns.

Remind children to throw away used tissues, cover their mouths when they cough or sneeze, keep their hands away from their face, and to wash hands often with soap and warm water will help keep everyone healthier.

We have seen an increase in Strep infections recently. Provided below is some information specific to Streptococcal Infections. We have seen an increase and signs and symptoms related to Streptococcal Infections. Please monitor your children and follow the guidelines presented in this letter. On the back is the district guidelines on keeping your child at home. If you have any questions please contact the health office.

Streptococcal Infection (Strep Throat, Scarlet Fever)

caused by group A beta hemolytic Streptococcus, a bacterium

Signs and Symptoms	Sudden onset of headache, fever, sore throat, sometimes accompanied by rash. Scarlet Fever is characterized by a skin rash that often appears as fine, red bumps that feel like sandpaper on the neck, chest, groin and/or inner surface of knees, thighs and elbows.
Incubation	2–5 days
Contagious Period	As long as organism is present in the nose or throat.
Mode of Transmission	Direct contact with oral secretions from case or carrier.
Management of Other Children	Any child with sore throat or fever should be referred for medical attention. Encourage handwashing by all children and staff.
When to Exclude a Child	Exclude child until treated with antibiotics for 24 hours.
Vaccine Requirements	There is currently no vaccine available for this disease.
Reporting Requirements	Must be reported to your local health department only if multiple cases occur.


