Sawyer W. competed in the Masonry competition which included a skills performance assessing his ability to safely construct a composite brick and block project with details typically found in residential and commercial construction. Additionally, Sawyer completed a written exam assessing mastery of brick masonry techniques including use of hand tools, power tools, measuring equipment/tools, and blueprint reading. What an amazing experience this was for our students.


Pablo Cartaya, famous author, visits Middle School Students




Valley Early Childhood School
