Addison Central School District Board of Education selects new superintendent

The Addison Central School District Board of Education appointed Jim Peiffer as the new Superintendent of Schools at its July 9 meeting. Peiffer has been serving as acting/interim superintendent since January, while also serving the district as Executive Director of Curriculum and Instruction, the position he's held since July 2021.

Before his employment with Addison, Peiffer spent eight years as the Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum and Instruction in the Penfield Central School District. From 2008-13, he worked in the Starpoint Central School District as an assistant principal and then as principal. Peiffer was a Coordinator for Instructional Technology Integration, Staff and Curriculum Development for Erie 1 BOCES from 2006-08. Prior to that, he was a classroom teacher in the West Seneca Central School District for seven years.

Peiffer earned a bachelor's degree in elementary education from Daemen College and a master's degree in elementary education from Buffalo State College. He earned a master's degree in educational administration from Canisius College.

"We are thankful for all stakeholders involved in making this a fully comprehensive search process," Addison Board of Education President Marty Wheeler said. "I am excited to have Mr. Peiffer accept the position of ACSD Superintendent. He will lead our district well with his positivity, relational mindset, commitment to students and pursuit of excellence.
