Public Library Report

At this time, Superintendent DioGuardi presented the 2013-2014 budget for those in attendance. He began by stating that this year the format was submitted a little differently. He and Mr. Forrester reviewed each category comparing to this year versus the proposed for next year. They explained where the increases were and the reason. However, as stated in previous years, the District has no control over 78 to 80% of the budget because it is made up of payroll, benefits, utilities, etc. Another example of an uncontrolled expense is the amount for the TRS & ERS contributions that are required by the State.

In conclusion, Mr. DioGuardi said the proposed budget for 2013-14 is \$26,227,710, the proposed increase in the property tax levy is 2.9% and a 3.3% budget-to-budget increase.

Mr. Forrester then stated that the vote is May 21st, 2013 from noon to 8:00 p.m. and one Board member would be elected and Trustee Brian Herrington is running unopposed.
