He said the audit is scheduled every 5 years (this is the second one) and he reviewed their countered information with our facts for the period July 1, 2012 through December 15, 2015 regarding our financial condition. He noted the district budgets are submitted conservatively to ensure that unanticipated expenditures do not result in mid-year budget cuts which then would have an impact on our students. The conservative budget also results in budget surpluses at the end of the year which then is reviewed by the Board and administration to determine the best use of the surpluses. He also pointed out in the response letter that in this era of the property tax cap, the gap elimination adjustment, and Foundation Aid not being awarded as prescribed by law, we have not had to eliminate Programs. During the 2014-2015 school year, the Board of Education authorized the liquidation of its insurance reserve and also partially liquidated unemployment reserve. These are just a few facts that were submitted in the responsive letter.
